- □ I understand that the Approved FHOG Participant is not authorised by the State Revenue Department of Western Australia to offer any advice or assistance on the conditions of eligibility for the grant, or in the completion of the application.
- □ I understand that the State Revenue Department of Western Australia may give some of this information to other government agencies authorised by law to receive it.
- □ I authorise the State Revenue Department of Western Australia to deposit the grant into the account nominated in section 4.

Note: Penalties for making a false or misleading statement in or in connection with an application for a first home owner grant carries a maximum penalty of \$20,000 under the Western Australian First Home Owner Grant Act 2000.

Evidence to be submitted in support of the application

The following documentation must be sighted by the Approved FHOG Participant or the State Revenue Department of Western Australia and must be submitted in support of the application.

The documentation is required as proof of Australian Citizenship or Permanent Resident status for one of the applicants:

- For Australian Citizen applicants born in Australia: an original or certified copy of an Australian Passport or an original or certified copy of the Birth Certificate or Extract of Birth;
- For Australian Citizen applicants not born in Australia: an original or certified copy of an Australian Passport or an original or certified copy of the Australian Citizenship Certificate.
- For Non Australian Citizen residents: the original or certified copy of their Permanent Resident Visa (Australia Resident visa), or for Special Category Visa holders (eg. New Zealand citizens), the original or certified copy of their Passport.

Terms Used

Applicant(s) - A person(s) who, on completion of the purchase of an established home or construction of a new home, will be an owner.

Applicant's Spouse - The person to whom the applicant is married or with whom the applicant has been cohabiting, on a genuine domestic basis in a relationship of de facto marriage for at least 2 years at the time of the commencement of the eligible transaction.

Approved FHOG Participant - financial institutions approved to received this application on behalf of the State Revenue Department.

Certified copy – a copy of an original that has been sighted by an acceptable referee under the Financial Transaction Reports Act 1988 and noted on the copy that it is a true copy of the original. An acceptable referee includes; Police Officer, Bank Employee, Justice of the Peace, Minister of Religion, Pharmacist, Medical Practitioner, Dentist, Public Servant, Primary or Secondary Teacher, Member of Parliament, Legal Practitioner.

Contract to build – a contract under which a builder agrees to build a home from the start of building work to when it is ready for occupation.

Established home - A home that is already built and ready for occupancy.

FHOG - First Home Owner Grant.

Home - Is a building, affixed to land, that-

- (a) may lawfully be used as a place of residence; and
- (b) is, in the Commissioner's opinion, a suitable building for use as a place of residence.

Intended Date of Occupancy - Is the date on which the applicant(s) expects to commence living in the house as their principal place of residence.

Notifiable Event - When any part of the eligibility criteria is not met, the applicant(s) must notify the Commissioner within 14 days from the occurrence of this event. For example, when the applicant(s) does not occupy the home as their principal place of residence within 12 months.

Owner builder - An owner of land who builds a home, or has a home built, on the land without entering into a Contract to Build.

Owner/Home Owner - A person who has a relevant interest in land on which a home is built.

Permanent Resident - A person who holds a permanent visa within the meaning of section 30 of the Migration Act 1958 of the Commonwealth; or a New Zealand citizen who is the holder of a special category visa within the meaning of Section 32 of the Migration Act 1958 of the Commonwealth and has satisfied the Commissioner that he or she intends to reside permanently in Australia.

Relevant Interest - A relevant interest in land refers to the means by which a person holds their interest in the land. This commonly is an estate in fee simple. Other forms of interest are defined in the Act.
